

Changes to Apprenticeship Funding Effective from April 2017



1. Are you aware of the changes the government are making to Apprenticeship Funding from April 2017?
2. From that time the government will require a **mandatory cash contribution** from smaller businesses (i.e. those with an annual pay bill of less than £3m).
3. Revised proposals (announced 12th August 2016) suggest non-Levy paying companies must pay for 10% of training costs.

This may yet change as previous proposals said if an Apprenticeship is valued at £3,000, the employer pays £1,000.

4. Apprenticeships are still funded up until April 2017.
