On completion of the course, delegates will be able to confidently manage a casualty who is injured at work, or suffers a serious illness, whilst waiting for more qualified medical help to arrive.

Practical Skills are assessed by observation by the trainer and a written assessment checks understanding.

IOSH Working Safely - £150 + vat pp

This 1-day IOSH course is intended for personnel at all levels in all organisations. It may be arranged for Apprentices, adult workers, office staff or supervisors who have no formal safety and health training.

On completion of the course, delegates will be capable of recognising workplace hazards, enable appropriate preventative or control measures to be taken and become responsible both to themselves and to others regarding Health & Safety.

IOSH Working Safely is recognised by CSCS as an equivalent to a Level 1 Award in Health and Safety in a Construction Environment. This means that delegates who successfully complete Working Safely can apply for a CSCS green Labourer card (in conjunction with the CITB Health, Safety and Environment Operatives Test).

A written assessment checks understanding.

Upon successful completion for the course, an IOSH certificate is issued which is valid for 3 years.

Abrasive Wheels - £55 + vat pp

This ½ day abrasive wheels course is suitable for all operators, supervisors and managers, who as part of their working duties select, mount, use or inspect abrasive wheels in accordance with the requirements of the PUWER (1998) Regulations.
