Empowering SMEs News

Rochdale Training has welcomed the news, that the UK government is introducing significant reforms to the Apprenticeship system, with particular support for our small and medium-sized enterprises (SMEs) and young people. The changes, include scrapping co-investment payments for apprentices under 22 in SMEs and doubling the amount of funding that can be transferred from apprenticeship levy-payers to other businesses, from 25% to 50%.

Prime Minister, Rishi Sunak aims to inject an additional £60 million into Apprenticeships, leading to an estimated 20,000 more Apprenticeships.
